

PRIZES TERMS AND CONDITIONS



Prizes are subject to availability and we reserve the right to withdraw or change them at any time. In the event of a prize being withdrawn we may replace it with an alternative or reduce the number of prizes for that Award.

1. Youth Worker of the Year

It's all about being exceptional. For the individual whose contribution to youth work is outstanding.

1.1 Who's it for?

For a youth worker who's excelled at building positive relationships with young people, helping them to see their potential and fulfil it. Their faith inspires everything they do and they work to the highest standards of best practice. They are hard-working, patient and caring and a great example to young people.

1.2 Who's eligible?

To be eligible for this Award, the nominated person must be a part time or full time paid youth worker over the age of 18 serving in a church or organisation.

1.3 Prizes Information

1.3.1 Holiday sponsored by Living Sun Holidays.

Any holiday from current Living Sun brochure for up to two people up to the value of £1,000. The holiday must be booked by end of April 2012 and taken by end of October 2012. It includes accommodation and half board but not other costs and flights. Living Sun Holidays may help you source flights if required, at your own expense. For example two people could go to Turkey for a week at any time of the season with full access to water sports equipment, half board with a continental breakfast and an evening meal provided. Alternatively you could hit the slopes of the Alps of France for a week with food provided, in different locations for skiers of all abilities and all right next to the lifts to ensure ease of use. Please note if you go for this option you would need to purchase a Lift Pass at the resort of choice.

2. Volunteer of the Year

It's about being devoted. For the volunteer who shows wholehearted commitment in their service to young people.

2.1 Who's it for?

For a volunteer who's shown exceptional commitment to Christian youth work, freely offering their time and energy to serve young people. They are passionate, skilled, reliable and servant-hearted. They are the heroes of the youth work world and this Award celebrates all that they give to make youth work happen.

2.2 Who's eligible?

To be eligible for this Award, the nominated person must be an unpaid volunteer over the age of 18 serving in a church or organisation.

2.3 Prizes

2.3.1 SoulNet Retreat ticket sponsored by Soul Survivor

One ticket to the 2012 SoulNet weekend retreat for youth workers at Center Parcs in Sherwood Forest on 3rd to 5th February 2012. Includes entry to the retreat including accommodation and use of Center Parc's facilities but not transport or food.

For a project or piece of work that's bursting with faith and creativity. It may involve a fresh approach in an existing context or show innovation in reaching out to new groups of young people. It will have successfully overcome challenges or filled a gap in Christian youth work.

3.2 Who's eligible?

To be eligible for this Award, the nominated project can be an event or short or long term programme run by a church or organisation.

3.3 Prizes

3.3.1 Go Ape high wire adventure tickets sponsored by Cliff College

Four adult passes for a Go Ape high wire course at one of the 28+ Centres around the UK. Admission only. Tickets do not include food or transport.

4. Best Employer

It's about being nurturing. For the church or organisation that recognises the value of their youth workers.

4.1 Who's it for?

For an employer who gives outstanding support to their youth workers. They invest in them, providing practical and spiritual support and encouragement. They're committed to training and ongoing personal development. They value not only what youth workers do for young people, but also the youth workers themselves.

4.2 Who's eligible?

To be eligible for this Award, the nominated employer must be a church or organisation who oversees or manages one or more part time or full time paid youth workers.

4.3 Prizes

4.3.1 CPAS Growing Leaders Course materials sponsored by CPAS.

The Growing Leaders course focuses on developing leaders across the life of the church, and is a practical one year programme that equips local churches for mission by investing the adults and young people who lead others to Christ. The Growing Leaders – Youth Edition course is aimed at 14-18 year olds and is designed to run over two

terms with a mixture of teaching, mentoring and practical application to develop young people in leadership.
